*I, Clara* tells the extraordinary life story of Clara Wieck Schumann in her own words. Drawn from letters and diaries, and interspersed with live performances of her works, and music by Robert Schumann, Brahms, Liszt, Mendelssohn, and Chopin.

Clara Schumann was a truly exceptional woman, a groundbreaking musician in her own right - not just a devoted wife to the composer Robert Schumann. By the age of eight she was dazzling audiences throughout Europe. When her husband declined tragically into mental illness and an attempt at suicide, she continued both to run the household and to make an international concert career to support the family.

Clara championed the works of her husband and of Chopin, Mendelssohn, Brahms and many others. She herself was also a talented composer, producing a piano concerto, numerous solo piano works, chamber music and songs.



Songs from the Last Page is written and performed by the acclaimed composer and songwriter, Gareth Williams. Each song in the collection takes the last lines of iconic literature, the novels and stories that we love, such as *Great Expectations*, *Ulysses* and *Lanark* - and transforms these final pages into something brand new, sung from the piano, accompanied by violin and cello duo, Sequoia.


